



Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

Effective Date: [01/01/2024]

WS Telecom INC (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor") expects all customers and users of its services to comply with this Acceptable Use Policy (AUP). The following guidelines define acceptable use of the Contractor's services, including SDN, IP leasing, and routing services.

1. General Compliance

1.1 Customers must comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and industry standards while using WS Telecom INC services.

1.2 Prohibited activities include but are not limited to:

Illegal Use: Services may not be used for illegal activities, including fraud, identity theft, or distribution of prohibited materials.

Phishing and Malware: Sending phishing emails or distributing viruses, worms, or malicious code.

SPAM and UCE: Sending unsolicited commercial emails is strictly prohibited.

Copyright Violation: Hosting or distributing content that infringes on intellectual property rights.

Security Breach: Unauthorized access to networks, systems, or data.

1.3 Actions causing harm to WS Telecom INC infrastructure, such as DDoS attacks or unauthorized scanning of systems, are strictly prohibited.

2. Use of Services

2.1 Services provided by WS Telecom INC are intended for lawful business purposes only. Customers are responsible for their activities and those of their end-users.

2.2 Customers must ensure that their use of services, including leased IP space and SDN, complies with this AUP.
